## St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands

The largest of the U.S. Virgin Islands is a gorgeous tropical oasis of powder-white beaches, crystalline seas, lush rainforest landscapes and a tranquil eco-preserve. St. Croix also has an intriguing heritage that includes a Danish-built fortress.



## Basseterre, St. Kitts

St. Kitts was a tropical prize over which the European powers fought for more than a century. Discover French and British heritage in Basseterre and the complex colonial legacy amongst the ruins of fortresses and once-grand estates.

## Fort De France, Martinique

Known for its dramatic mountains and smoldering Mount Pelée volcano, Martinique's landscape is unforgettable. Soak in the fast-paced vibe of cosmopolitan Fort-de-France while touring sites like Fort St. Louis and the Cathédrale St. Louis. Then slow things down outside of town with a snorkel session at Rocher du Diamant— from rainforest trails to stunning beaches, Martinique's wild side offers it all.
